- Originally open only to state agencies
- The FOIA law requires state agencies to post meetings
 - Agenda
 - Minutes
- This has been the subject of AG's opinions from time to time



- Senate Bill 212 requires GIC to make the Calendar available to municipal governments
- A recent update to the calendar does that and creates a subtle "branding" to help distinguish local from state agency meetings

Local Notices

- SB 212 also required us to create a "Legal Notices" site for local governments
- Similar to and linked to the state bids directory
 - bids.delaware.gov
- We created a very simple, WordPress site for local government legal notices
 - Based on <u>news.delaware.gov</u>
 - Many of you already use WordPress

- Step one: request creation of a category for your municipality
 - email to <u>mike.mahaffie@state.de.us</u>
- Step two: we create a username for you on the Local Notices system
 - Take Note: This will be different from your town web site log-in
- Step three: post text-based notices
 - <u>localnotices.delaware.gov</u>
